Turkeys will be running for their lives and we will all gain a few unwanted pounds. But it is worth it.

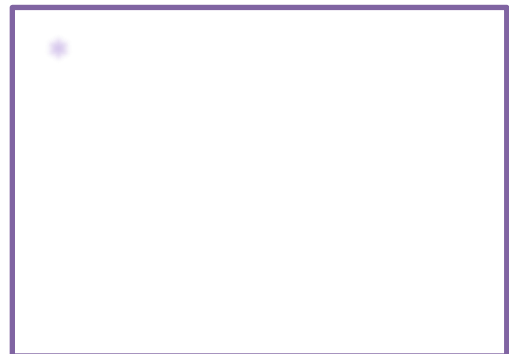
