Children would walk to the nearest school sometimes a mile or more away from home. Some students would ride a pony keeping it in a little shed or fenced in area near the school while in classes.

The schoolhouse was a small building that was used for school classes-community events- meetings and voting.

Morning farm chores were done first then the children would get ready for school. There were cows to be milked and animals to be cleaned, fed and watered. Children also had other chores such as husking the corn in the field before school began. Children would begin their day with the Pledge of Allegiance one student would lead the Pledge. The students would stand by the desk with their right hand across their chest.

At times the community would join the children in special events and they would have gatherings at the schoolhouse to provide support. Have fun reminiscing about your first day of school.

Recipe From The Kitchen

OREO POKE CAKE

Ingredients

- 1 boxed vanilla cake mix (I used Betty Crocker Super Moist, French Vanilla) and ingredients to prepare cake
- Family-size box of Double Stuff Oreos (1 lb. 4 oz.)
- 4.2 oz. box Oreo Cookies & Cream pudding
- 3.5 oz. box Hershey's White Chocolate pudding
- 4 cups milk
- 8 oz. Cool Whip

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit.
2. Grease the bottom of a 13x9 inch baking pan and fill with Oreo cookie halves - cream side up (set aside the other halves for later).
3. Prepare cake mix as directed and pour over Oreos in pan.
4. Bake cake according to instructions on box.
5. While the cake bakes, whisk together the Cookies & Cream pudding and 2 cups milk, taking care not to whisk it too long - it needs to be a pourable consistency.
6. While cake is still warm, poke holes in the cake with the end of a wooden spoon and pour the Cookies and Cream pudding over the top.
7. Allow the pudding to soak into the cake for about 2-4 minutes.
8. Place the cake in the fridge and allow to cool for about 30 minutes - 1 hour.
9. Whisk together the White Chocolate pudding and remaining 2 cups milk.
10. Add the Cool Whip.
11. Crush the remaining Oreo cookies (along with the halves from earlier in the recipe) and add half of the cookies to the Cool Whip/pudding mixture.
12. Spread the mixture on top of the cake and top with remaining crushed Oreos.
13. Chill for 1-2 hours before serving.
