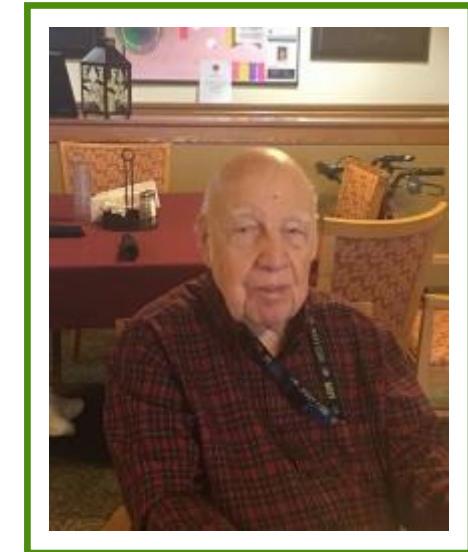

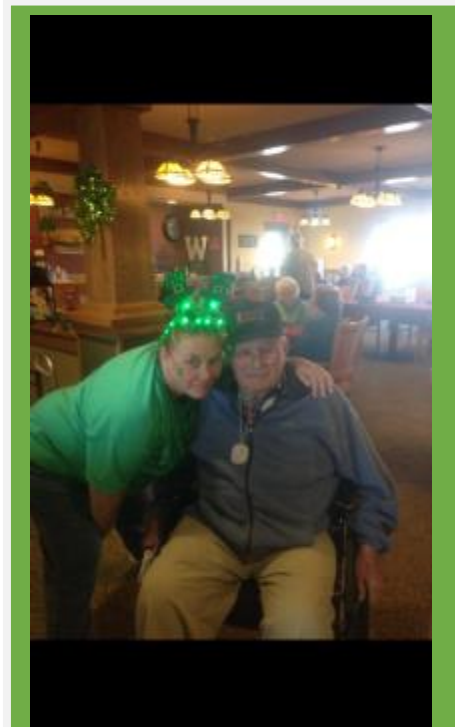

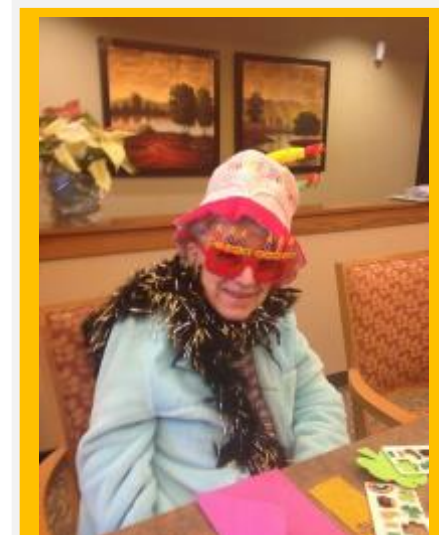


All Hail the Queen...Lena found the baby in this years Mardi Gras King Cake and became queen for the day!
