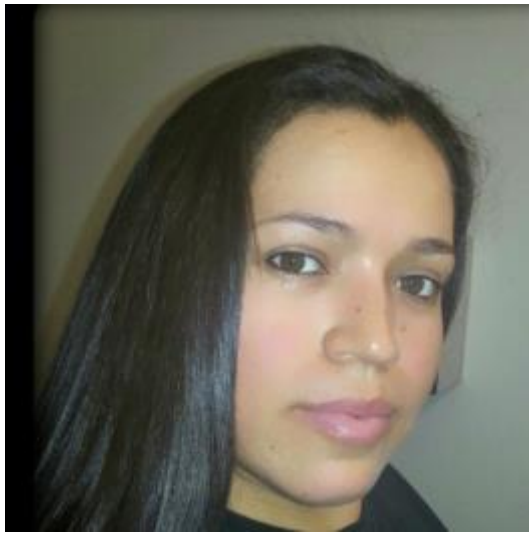

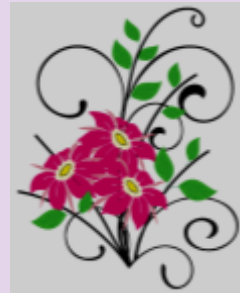
May's Staff Spotlight
