July is Freedom Month and I thought this was a great opportunity to remind all residents about their freedoms and rights when living here at Windsor. When you move in you sign an occupancy agreement, and this includes 19 resident rights. This list includes such things as being treated respectfully and with appropriate and adequate care and to be address in an appropriate manner. You have the right to be free from mental and physical abuse and to be free from restraints. Each resident here at Windsor has the right to refuse services at any given time and keep their personal and medical care private. They have the right to practice their own religion and the freedom to exercise their rights as a citizen, including voting. Residents have the right to present grievances with out free of reprisal or discrimination and receive a timely response to all requests. You have the right to manage your own finances unless a legal representative has been appointed. Your may access your healthcare information at any time and you have the right to request accounting and disclosure of healthcare information that you made to other organizations. Residents have the right to due process and to enter into contracts. For a copy of your rights please let me know.
