National Immunization Awareness Month

August is national immunization awareness month and in the midst of a concern over the Delta Variant (also known as SARS-COVID2) this is a good time to become familiar with the COVID vaccine and other vaccines that are beneficial to your health. There are 3 immunizations that have been recommended for older adults for many years. Those immunizations are for shingles (Shingrix), pneumonia (Pneumovax 23), and another for pneumonia (Pevnar 13). Along with these 3 immunizations, many healthcare providers now recommend that older adults are vaccinated for COVID. While this is a newer immunization, there have been very few serious side effects reported. Most healthcare providers agree that the benefits of the immunization outweigh the risks of rare side effects. If you have any questions about whether or not you are up to date on your vaccinations, let me know and I will be glad to look on the Iowa Registry of Immunizations.
