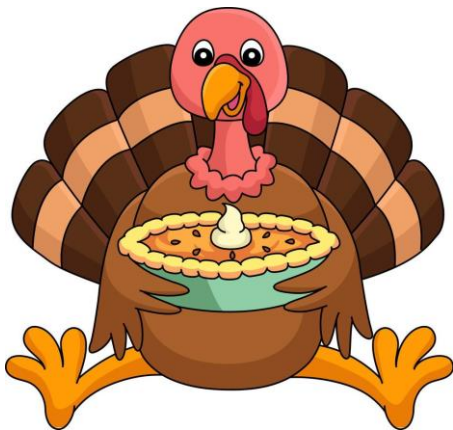

Ingredients

- ☐ 2 quarts apple juice
- ☐ 1-pint cranberry juice
- ☐ 3/4 cups sugar
- ☐ 2 cinnamon sticks
- ☐ 1 teaspoon allspice
- ☐ 1 small orange
- ☐ 8 whole cloves

Instructions

- In a large crockpot, combine juices and sugar. Add cinnamon sticks and allspice.
- Poke cloves into the orange and add it to the mixture.
- Cook on high for 1 hour, then on low for 4 to 8 hours.
- Serve hot.
